## **Identifying, Locating, and Assessing Students who have Special**

All children with disabilities, who are in need of Special Education and related services, shall be identified, located, and assessed. Your Local Education Agency (local public school district) seeks and accepts referrals to assess children who have, or who are suspected of having a disability which impedes his/ her success in school. It is the responsibility of the School District to evaluate those students to determine if they are eligible for Special Education or related services under IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act).

If you suspect that your child, at any age, may need an evaluation to determine eligibility for Special Education services, you may request an evaluation, at no cost, at your child's school. Please contact the Principal at your child's school for information about referring your child for an evaluation. For referring children ages birth to five, please contact your Local Education Agency at one of the numbers below.
